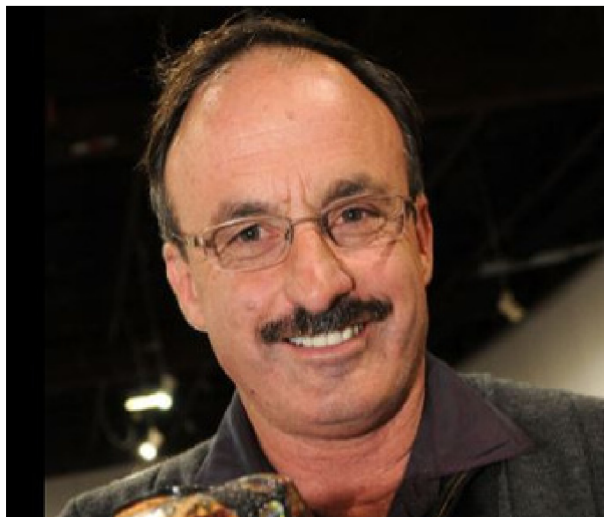

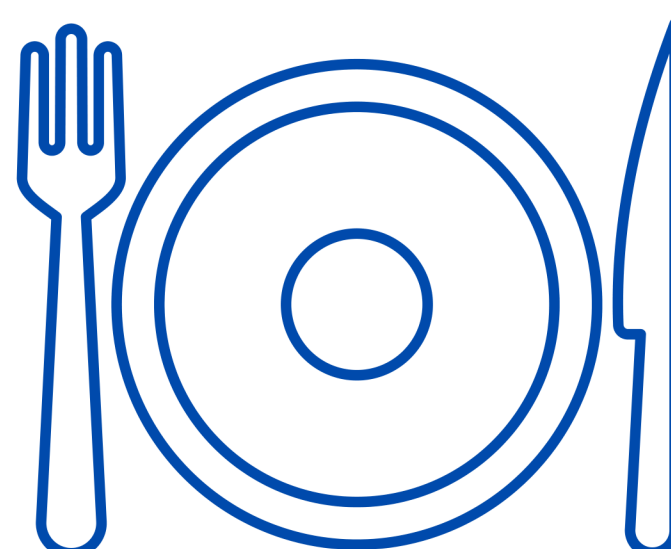

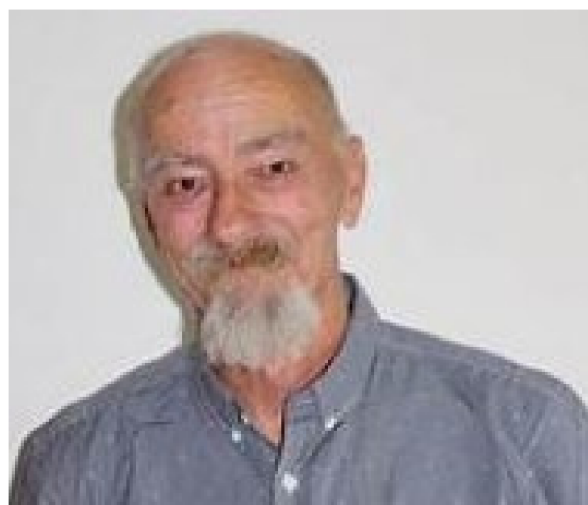

1.00pm Demo by Mike Walker - Turning Slow



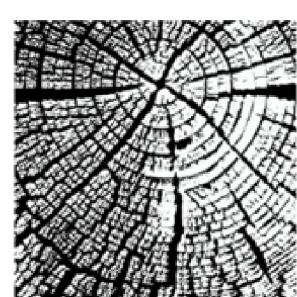
