

HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

The National Association of Woodworkers has a responsibility and commitment to assist its members to keep themselves safe while pursuing woodworking activities and will provide a set of minimum safety standards that will ensure their own safety and the safety of others.

NAW will:

- Foster positive health and safety practices,
- Identify common hazards and provide best methods to eliminate, isolate or minimise these,
- Consult with ACC, Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment, and Health and Safety stakeholders and provide updates and information to members,
- Establish an accident register to assist in identifying hazards and trends, and
- Encourage Clubs to appoint a Health and Safety Officer who will be responsible for the safety and well-being of club members during club activities.

Members will:

- Contribute to hazard identification,
- Adopt safe work practices,
- Encourage others to do the same, and
- Report injuries promptly and accurately.

This policy will be reviewed every two years.
